

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN-PEN OR PENCIL HOLDER.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 19,278, dated August 20, 1889.

Application filed July 10, 1889. Serial No. 317,054. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWARD TODD, Jr., a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Fountain-Pen Holders and Pencils; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side view of a fountain-pen holder showing my design, and Fig. 2 is a longitudinal sectional view of a portion of my design as applied to the body of a fountain-pen or pencil.

The main feature of my design consist a sleeve or jacket bearing upon its outer face a series of slightly raised protubers or knobs, so located with reference to other as to form an indented spiral ridge ing the form of a uniformly-mangled so thread, as shown.

What I claim is—

The design for a fountain-pen or pener holder herein shown and described.
