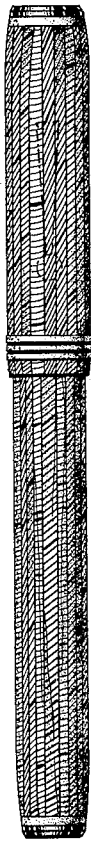

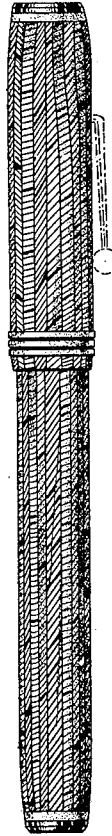
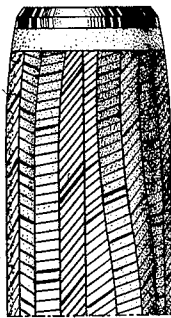

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Henry Zoll, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Elmhurst, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Fountain Pens or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen embodying the new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevational view of the pen,
Figure 3 is a top plan view of the fountain pen,
and
Figure 4 is a fragmentary side elevational view on an enlarged scale of the upper portion of the fountain pen cap, for the purpose of more clearly bringing out the details of ornamentation.
