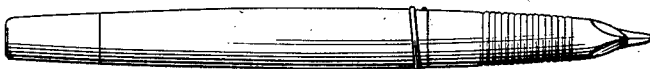

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Victor H. Severy, residing at Atlanta, in the county of Fulton and State of Georgia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Adjustable Nib Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side view with the cap in nib covering position.

Figure 2 is a side view with the cap in posi-

tion for use of the pen, and the nib in short position.

Figure 3 is a bottom plan view of the pen of Figure 2.

Figure 4 is a top plan view, and

Figure 5 is a top plan view of the pen with the nib in extended position.
