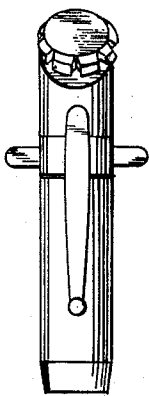

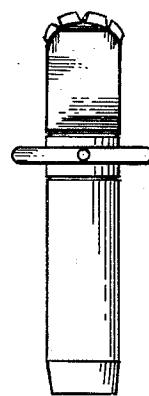

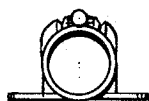

Be it known that I, Mendel Fried, a citizen of the United States, residing at Phoenix, State of Arizona, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen Cap, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.
