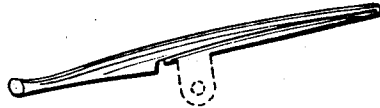

DESIGN FOR A PEN POINT

Charles K. Lovejoy, Needham, Mass.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles K. Lovejoy, a citizen of the United States, residing at Needham, in the county of Norfolk and State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pen Point, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a pen point showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a top plan of the same and

Figures 3, 4 and 5 are end elevations in section

respectively on the lines 3—3, 4—4 and 5—5 of Figure 2.

In Figures 1, 3, and 4 depending dotted lines indicate side lugs by which the pen point is mounted on a pen section or other holder, these lugs being ordinarily concealed from view by the holder.

The essential features of my design are shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a pen point, substantially as shown and described.
