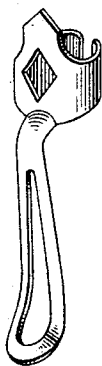

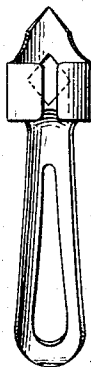
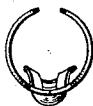

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OTTO HUBER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Bronx, New York city, in the county of Bronx and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pen and Pencil Clips, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In said drawing—Figure 1 is a perspective view of the clip showing my new design; Fig. 2 is a plan from the under side, and Fig. 3 is a rear end elevation of the same.
